

## DANIEL 6:1-5 (ESV)

Final Constructions of the set over the kingdom 120 satraps, to be throughout the whole kingdom; <sup>2</sup> and over them three high officials, of whom Daniel was one, to whom these satraps should give account, so that the king might suffer no loss. <sup>3</sup> Then this Daniel became distinguished above all the other high officials and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom.





## DANIEL 6:6-9 (ESV)

Control Correction of the second straps came by agreement to the king and said to him, "O King Darius, live forever! 7 All the high officials of the kingdom, the prefects and the satraps, the counselors and the governors are agreed that the king should establish an ordinance and enforce an injunction, that whoever makes petition to any god or man for thirty days, except to you, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions.









# Daniel 6:19-24 (ESV)

Variable (1974) (1977) \*\*\* Then, at break of day, the king arose and went in haste to the den of lions. \*\*\* As he came near to the den where Daniel was, he cried out in a tone of anguish. The king declared to Daniel, \*\*O Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you from the lions?\*\* \*\*\* Daniel said to the king, \*\*O king, live forever!

#### Daniel 6:25-28 (ESV)

Daniel 6:25-28 (ESV) 28 Then King Darius wrote to all the peoples, nations, and languages that dwell in all the earth: "Peace be multiplied to you. 24 I make a decree, that in all my royal dominion people are to tremble and fear before the God of Daniel, for he is the living God, enduring forever, this kingdom shall never be destroyed, and his dominion shall be to the end. 27 He delivers and rescues; he works signs and wonders in heaven and on earth, he who has saved Daniel from the power of the lions."<sup>24</sup> 25 to this Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius and the reign of Cyrus the Persian.
