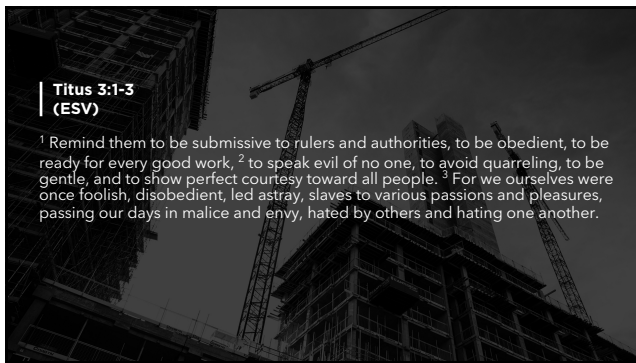


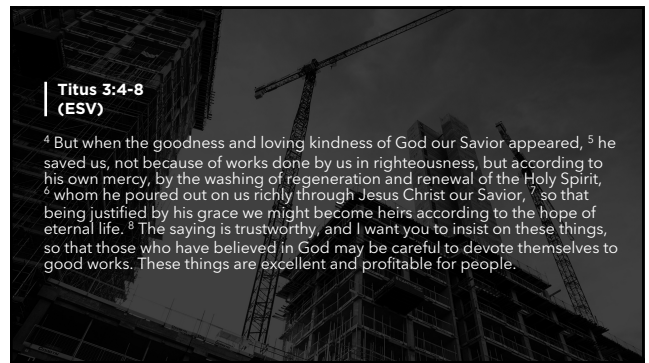
**Titus 2:11-15

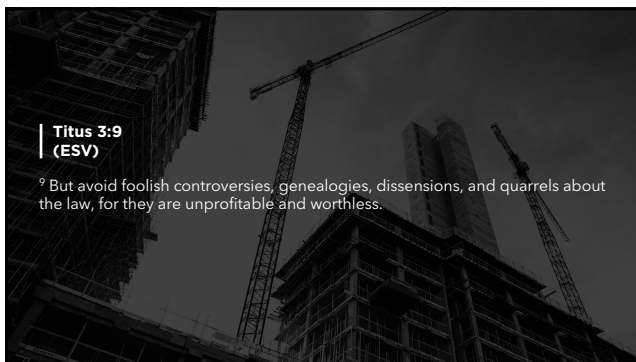

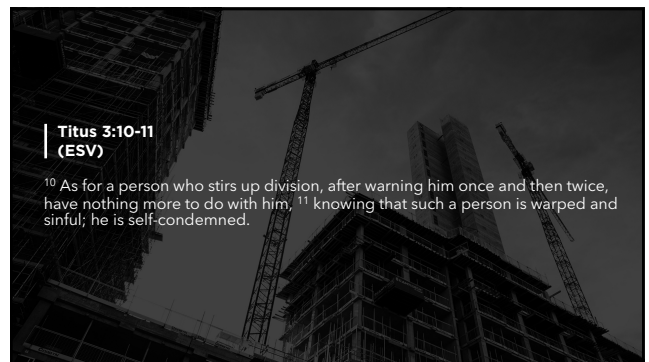
**Titus 3:4-8
